PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE TO THE FLAG:

1. PUBLIC COMMENT PERIOD (NOT TO EXCEED A TOTAL OF 15 MINUTES):

Darryl Scheck, representing SEIU Local 2020, spoke about salary surveys recently released by the City versus salary surveys that SEIU has conducted. He distributed the SEIU salary survey, the procedure from the Memorandum of Understanding, and per capita City data. He stated the expectation that SEIU members would accept a salary increase in an amount less than last year was unrealistic given the overall improvement in economic conditions.
