**AUTHORIZING THE IMPLEMENTATION OF A COMMUNITY CHOICE
AGGREGATION PROGRAM BY PARTICIPATING IN MONTEREY BAY
COMMUNITY POWER'S (MBCP) COMMUNITY CHOICE AGGREGATION
PROGRAM.**

The ordinance will implement a community choice aggregation program within the jurisdiction of the City by participating as a group in the Community Choice Aggregation Program of MBCP in an effort to achieve reduced greenhouse gas emissions, local renewable power development, competitive electric rates, and the implementation of energy conservation. The Program will benefit the City and its residents by offering them a choice in energy providers in addition to cost-savings.
