REGULATIONS FOR COMMERCIAL SPECIALTY STRUCTURES OPERATING ON AND OR UPON CITY FACILITIES

- 1.** Owner/Vendors of all Commercial Specialty Structures to be operated on City Facilities must obtain an annual operating permit approved by the Director of Recreation and Parks
- 2.** The fee for the annual operating permit 2021 is set at \$289.50 Permits are valid from January 1st to December 31st of a calendar year. Owner/Vendors may utilize one permit for up to four inflatable units. Operating permit fees are not pro-rated, the full fee must be paid before an operating permit is issued.
- 3.** Annual operating permits must be renewed by January 10th of each year.
- 4.** Owner/Vendor operating Commercial Specialty Structures on City facilities without a permit, after January 1, 2021 will be subject to a minimum \$50.00 fine per occurrence.
- 5.** Owner/Vendors are required to review and sign a copy of the Park Rules verifying their knowledge and intent to comply with all the rules and conditions.
- 6.** Owner/Vendors will be issued up to 4 “permit stickers” one for each inflatable unit, this sticker must always be prominently displayed on the unit or a placard that is affixed to the ground, it must be facing in the direction of the nearest street.
- 7.** Owner/Vendor must provide proof of a current business license issued by the City of Santa Maria.
- 8.** Owner/Vendor shall procure and maintain public liability insurance against claims for injuries to persons or damages to property which may arise from or in connection with the delivery and operation of a Specialty Structure on a City facility hereunder and results of that operation by the Contractor, his agents, representatives, employees or subcontractors.
- 9.** Owner/Vendor coverage shall be at least as broad as:
 - a.** Insurance Services Office Commercial General Liability coverage (occurrence Form CG 0001.)
 - b.** Insurance Services Office Form Number CA 0001 covering Automobile Liability, Code #1 (any auto).
 - c.** Worker’s Compensation insurance as required by State of California and Employer’s Liability Insurance.
- 10.** Owner/Vendor shall maintain limits no less than:
 - a.** General Liability: of not less than \$1,000,000 per occurrence for bodily injury, personal injury and property damage.

- b. Automobile Liability: of not less than \$1,000,000 per accident for bodily injury and property damage
 - c. Employer's Liability: Not less than \$1,000,000 per accident for bodily injury or disease.
- 11. The general liability and automobile liability policies are to contain, or be endorsed to contain, the following provisions:
 - a. The City, its Officers, Officials, Employees and Volunteers are to be covered as insured with respect to liability arising out of automobiles, owned, leased, hired or borrowed by or on behalf of the contractor and with respect to liability arising out of work or operations performed by or on behalf of the Owner/Vendor including materials, parts or equipment furnished in connection with such work or operations.
 - b. For any claims related to this project, the Owner/Vendor's insurance Officials, Employees and Volunteers.
Each insurance policy required by this clause shall be endorsed to state that coverage shall not be canceled by either party, except after thirty (30) day's prior written notice by certified mail, return receipt requested, has been given to the Entity.
- 12. Owner/Vendor shall furnish the City with original Insurance certificates and amendatory endorsements effecting coverage required by this clause. All Insurance certificates and endorsements are to be received and approved by the City before the annual operating permit will be issued and valid. All insurance coverage must remain in full force for the term of the permit issued.
- 13. The department has designated a specific location at Rod Rodenberger Park and Pioneer Park, for inflatables to be located. (Attachments 2 and 3) Inflatables or other type structures located outside of these areas are subject to citation.
- 14. Owner/Vendor shall furnish own electrical source for structures at sit with exception to Rod Rodenberger Park. All generators must be enclosed with a noise muffling material and it is the Owner/Vendors responsibility to ensure that all park patrons and surrounding neighbors are not disturbed by the noise created by your equipment.
- 15. An electrical outlet is provided at Rod Rodenberger Park for your use. NO electric generators of any type are allowed at this location. You must use the electrical outlet provided next to the approved site on which to locate the inflatable, (see attachment 2). If the electrical outlet is not functioning, please contact the Santa Maria Police Department's non-emergency number (805) 928-7381 and report the problem. Even in this case **generators are not permitted**.
