He was significant in that not only did he draw the plans for many of the homes in Santa Maria, he designed the beautiful City Hall.
- d. **Discussion of former Hancock flying School mess hall for special designation:** There still has been no reply from the Eagles organization, present owners of the property. Jim will continue to communicate with their leaders.

- a. **Japanese Methodist Church:** Dick had talked with the minister in October who had appeared very interested in receiving an award. However, there has been no further communication. Jim will follow up to see if they have considered the proposal.
