- Built in 1926-era, Japanese Language school, they had "Shige" which is classical opera & Bonsai gardens, Judo, large community center building where parking lot is now
  (demolished due to cost of renovations needed)- once gathering place of people returning from internment camps

- Essay for Black/Gold Library of CA from Dawn talks about history
- Guadalupe Japanese Men's Association bought the land, men intended to earn money and return to Japan, but stayed- assimilated, ordered brides (etc.), needed gathering place for community. Info on construction needed to be researched
- Purpose is to recognize the Japanese Community prior to the participants becoming deceased, raise awareness, etc....(per Jim Z.) Archive for future generations...(per Dawn).
- Letter of Interest is needed from Jap Community Center expressing in interest in moving forward towards Place of Historic Merit (without encumbrances). Mrs. Azama(?) may have more info- board member in 1950's (other noted families include Minami, Tamooka's)
- Many former members and participants are now elderly, suffering from advanced age health complications, and/or deceased
- Guadalupe has a similar Historic Organization
