1. Call to Order:

Committee Chair Jim Zemaitis called the meeting to order at 4:00 p.m.

3. Minutes: Tim Larson moved to accept the minutes of April 10, 2012, seconded by Jim Zemaitis with the following corrections.

Comments: Correction of the April minutes: There was a numbering mistake of the items although no information was missing. Also, #6 New Business, "Marian" was misspelled "Marion," which was corrected.

4. Old Business:

- a. Digitization of committee records: Chair Jim Zemaitis was not able to bring the work he's doing on organizing the digitization of committee files. He will continue working on it and report on his progress at our next meeting.
- b. Hancock College of Aeronautics Mess Hall for special designation: An event to present the Object of Historical Merit Award to the building owners will take place at the building on College Ave., June 12, 2012. The Landmark Committee will meet at 4:00 pm in their designated library room, and leave for the ceremony at 4:30 p.m. Members of the Eagles are arranging the event. Chair Jim Zemaitis is trying to contact men who were cadets at the school to attend.
- c. Bill's Take Out for special designation: There are two owners. Helen Guido, who has sent a letter of request for an award, and a Mr. Nolan, who has not. Tim has 1951-52 photographs of the building and area, showing the Sears Roebuck building across the street. The tenant is working on a time-line.

d. Marian Residence: Ryan Fisher reported on information regarding the contact authority for the building, formerly called Our Lady of Perpetual Help Hospital, Sr. Patricia Raybourn, who resides in Redwood City. We discussed the subject of what award we anticipate to give, and targeted the award to be a City of Santa Maria Landmark. The building is in beautiful condition, well landscaped and very important to the population in the city, especially since it's where a great many of them were born.

5. New Business:

a. Chair Zemaitis assigned the committee to visit the current Landmark sites to assess their condition and to take pictures to be permanently filed and to be prepared to report at the July meeting.
